Strengthening Rural Health Care

Jon knows that rural hospitals are critical to the survival of every Montana community. Since 2020, Jon has secured nearly \$220 million to help Montana's rural hospitals and clinics support communities by meeting the most pressing health care challenges head-on.

Expanding Mental Health Care

Montanans are tough as nails, but Jon knows that even the toughest folks can go through hard times. That's why Jon is reaching across the aisle to help expand access to mental health centers across the state.

As young folks across Montana struggle with increased mental health issues, Jon took feedback from school leaders and introduced bipartisan legislation to improve schools' ability to access mental health resources.

Modernizing Montana's Health Infrastructure

In a state as big as Montana, folks often have to drive more than an hour to see their nearest doctor – that's why Jon is leading the charge to improve telehealth services. Following pressure from Jon, the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has reshaped policies to expand access to telehealth across Montana.

Jon knows that telehealth services only work when Montanans are connected, which is why he's fighting to bring high-speed internet to every household in the state. Through his *Bipartisan Infrastructure Law*, Jon secured resources to connect Montana households to high-speed internet so that folks can connect with health care providers remotely from anywhere.

Delivering for Veterans

As Chairman of the Senate Veterans Affairs Committee, Jon negotiated, wrote, and passed into law the bipartisan *PACT Act*, which is the largest expansion of health care benefits for veterans in decades. Jon's legislation delivers multiple generations of toxic-exposed veterans, including for thousands of Montanans, their earned health care and benefits.

Jon understands that in a rural state like Montana, access to quality care is critical. That's why he has been relentless in his push for more VA facilities, helping secure 12 new clinics across the state and the Southwest Montana Veterans Home in Butte. Jon also successfully urged the VA to deploy mobile Vet Centers to areas impacted by major flooding in 2022.
